Review:
Last week in Leviticus we saw that sin is the "blamable human <u>v</u> " of God's created
" $\underline{\underline{s}}$ " (the wholeness and joyful harmony with which God blessed the world at creation)
We saw that the sacrifices describe in Leviticus "covered" sin until Christ, the perfect sacrifice,
came who alone could "take away" the sin of the world (Hebrews 10:4, 11-14).

a. Jeremiah 17:9
b. Isaiah 53:6

d. Romans 3:10
2. "Christ is a great Savior"

C. God's P : Evidences of His Great Grace (10)
1. "Masterpiece" – cf. Romans 1:20 (God's s & i design in creation)
2. "Good works" – a r of being right with God, not the motive or the method
