Review

Eternity: "One Minute After You Die" (Thank you, Erwin Lutzer) (READ Revelation 21:1-8. 22-27: 22:1-5)

\Rightarrow	Heaven is a It is not a dream, an ethereal place of ghosts or phantoms. Jesus' resurrection body was a physical/spiritual body; it could be seen and touched. He ate. John says, "I sawI sawI heard"
\Rightarrow	Heaven is heaven because It's not about ponies, hot fudge sundaes, fishing, or golf. "God Himself will be with them" The presence of God with His people is a major biblical theme running deep in OT Scripture. God says, "I will dwell in the midst of them" and His glory is, at times, visible or absent (due to sin). Cf. Exodus 29:45-46; 33:14-15; Ezekiel 48:35
\Rightarrow	Heaven is the place of ultimate Not a hammock in the sky, but true Shalom: wholeness, peace, rest, fulness of joy. Rev. 21:4; Isaiah 25:6-8
\Rightarrow	Heaven will reveal what is truly What people value the most in this life will be seen for what it is. No one will be digging up the streets of gold. Cf. I Corinthians 3:12-15
\Rightarrow	Heaven will be a place of between people and nations, and a place of celebrating the glory of God in the redeemed of the world.
\Rightarrow	Heaven is an place, not a humdrum existence defined by "cloud-sitting" and harps. It will be a place of glory, beauty, worship, and service. Cf. I Corinthian 6:3; Rev. 22:3-5.
Two Choices, Two Destinies (READ Revelation 20:11-15; 21:8)	
\Rightarrow	Hear God's word: II Thessalonians 1:3-10 . Do you see the two destinies outlined here? This is why there is urgency to communicate the gospel.
\Rightarrow	Jesus describes two paths in Matthew 7:13-14 .
\Rightarrow	Listen to the Apostles as they preached: Acts 2:38-39; 3:19-21; 4:12
Responding to God's Word in Worship & Obedience	
\Rightarrow	Remember the old song, "When the Roll is Called Up Yonder"? Two questions: WILL you be there? And if you say yes, WHY will you be there?

⇒ **Romans 10:13** – "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." To "call on the name of the Lord" is to trust Christ as your Savior.
